What sparked your interest in farming, and why specifically hemp?

Farming has been in my blood for many generations. I grew up on a farm and wanted a horse of my own for as long as I can remember. As a young adult, I moved away

from all of that and lived in Florida and California. I always had access to a horse to love and ride wherever I moved. Also, I kept plants in my urban apartments and grew things like lettuce or tomatoes in pots outdoors. We moved to Tennessee to be closer to family, and the goal was to have a small homestead. We wanted to raise our kids with the freedom to explore outdoors and teach them about caring for animals and growing their own food. We started with animals: dogs, horses, barn cats, goats and chickens. The kids raised a small garden and we planted fruit trees. Hemp had been something we were interested in for years. We love clothing made from hemp, and the idea that it can replace so many plastics and is bio-degradable is appealing. It's eco-friendly, good for the soil, and has numerous uses and benefits... food, oil, medicine, building material, paper, and the list goes on. It grows fast and has awesome yields.
